Call for Application/Program of Young National Volunteers–CANUDC 2015



The national Organisation Committee of CANUDC 2015 (Cameroon National Universities Debating & Public Speaking Championships) launches from September 7 to October 7, 2015 a call for application for **26 youths** who will serve as national volunteers during the 3rd edition of CANUDC that will take place from November 10-15, 2015 at Université des Montagnes (West-Cameroon).

Their duties are scheduled up into five different domains:

V1 : Communication on TV, Radio, Newspapers (local, on the field).....	03 people
V2 : Online Communication & Social Networks	02 people
V3 : Computing, Tabulation, Conception & Designing (Computer Unit).....	03 people
V4 : Translation & interpretership, French-English(CDA Translation Committee).....	03 people
V5 : Local volunteers (Students from Université de Montagnes).....	15 people



All interested applicants shall send the three (3) following files to the Org. Committee (canudc@cameroondebate.org) before October 7, 2015:

- *Motivation Letter, indicating the field of volunteerism (choice 1, choice 2)*
- *CV*
- *Profile (biography+photo)*



The 11 Non-local Volunteers will work hand in hand with the 15 Local Volunteers from Université des Montagnes. It is worth mentioning that, there is no remuneration neither to national nor local Volunteers, thus they will receive technical and material assistance necessary for their duties.

In return, the **26 national young volunteers** will in short term benefit from training session organised by the National Organisation Committee, and, in long term, they will receive training and take part into local, nationwide and international events related to CDA's programs. Their profile will be retained in case of solicitation of employment or service provision by CDA's international partners.

All successful applicants will be called upon to take part in CANUDC 2015 and the last CANUDC preparatory session in early November at Université des Montagnes. They will be fed, lodged, and best volunteers will be awarded.
